Re: Highlights of Survey of North Dakota Eligible Voters

North Star Opinion Research conducted a survey of voters in North Dakota September 15-19, 2018, with all calls conducted after the allegations against Judge Brett Kavanaugh were made public. We find continued, strong support for Judge Kavanaugh's confirmation among voters in the state.

North Dakota voters say that the U.S. Senate should confirm Brett Kavanaugh's nomination to the Supreme Court by a 25-point margin.

North Dakota voters say that Judge Kavanaugh should be confirmed by 53 to 28 percent. This includes support among independents by a 54 to 24 percent margin, and among women by a 47 to 30 percent margin.

Methodology

The sample for this survey of eligible voters in North Dakota consists of 500 respondents selected from a list of registered voters. Field dates were September 15-19, 2018. All respondents confirmed that they are registered to vote in the state, and demographic quotas (county, race, gender, and age) were set to ensure the sample matches statistics for eligible voters. All interviews were conducted by telephone using live interviewers, and 52 percent of respondents were reached on a cell phone.
